# **Red Gold Tomatoes**

What is now Red Gold was started by Grover Hutcherson in 1942 in Orestes, Indiana, when he and his daughter Fran rebuilt a burned out cannery.

Fran married Ernie Reichart, and both he and their children became involved in the company. Red Gold bought out various companies but the name Red Gold was not used until the 1970's when they bought the cannery at Trafalgar, IN.

Red Gold consumes 95% of Indiana's tomato crop and 80% of all Midwestern tomatoes. Red Gold now has more than 3,000,000 square feet to the acre...that is 68+ acres under roof. Sizeable! They have 15 warehouses throughout the US and a fleet of 140 trucks.

For the general public, they have a wholesale warehouse in Elwood, IN that is open on certain days where you can buy scratch and dent and mislabeled containers that are still fresh and good for pennies on the dollar. Take a big vehicle when you go, you won't want to miss out on the bargains!






